Classes eligible for prizes with 4 entries or less will pay 1st prize only. Classes with 1 entry will pay no prize money but entry fee will be refunded.

CONDITIONS OF ENTRY – please read carefully

Entries:

- Please use 1 entry form per rider. Late entries cannot be accepted.
- Riders must sign the appropriate disclaimer form attached to the Entry Form.
- Riders compete at their own risk and must abide by the competition rules of the Equestrian Federation of Australia (EFA) and the Atherton Tablelands & District Dressage & Equestrian Association Inc. (ATDDEA).
- Official classes – EFA registration number and bridle number of horse, EFA rider membership number and sticker to be included with nominations.

Nominations:

- Not to exceed a maximum of three tests per day per horse/rider combination.
- Riders may not compete in senior and junior classes on the same horse.
- A horse is to be ridden by the one rider on the days of the competition.
- Junior riders competing in open classes to pay senior entry fees.
- No refund on nomination fees will be given after the closing date unless a Vet. or Doctor's certificate is produced. 50% of the nomination fee will be withheld for administration.
- Should the event be cancelled for any reason beyond the Club's control, any refund will be at the absolute discretion of the Committee and will be based upon the amount of irretrievable expenses for that particular event.

Junior classes – riders are under 18 years of age. Junior riders age as at 1st January 2009.

- **Junior Trot test;** Rider has not placed first, second or third with more than 7 horses or not competed in more than 5 dressage tests at EFA or Pony Club competitions. Riders entering these tests may not ride higher than Preliminary.

Open tests:

- **Class 6, 7, 10, 21 & 24: Open to both junior and senior riders;**
- **** Class 6 - Open Warm up Trot class** – This test is *open to juniors* who are exempt from entering the Junior trot test due to having competed in more than 5 dressage tests *and to all seniors* competing at the level according to their grading (be it Preliminary, or Advanced etc.). This test will be scored, ribbons to 6th place and no prize monies for this class.
- **Green Horse & Green rider classes;** Rider has not placed first, second or third with more than 7 horses or not competed in more than 5 dressage tests at EFA or Pony Club competitions. Riders entering these tests may not ride higher than Preliminary.

Levels -

- Horses may compete at 2 consecutive levels only; Trot/ Prelim., Prelim/Novice, Novice/Elem., etc. (exception is Open Warm up Trot test); (Green Horse & Green rider are preliminary level).
- Horses may compete HC below their EFA grading or one level above in both senior and junior classes.

Non-Members Insurance Levy –

- Riders who are not members of the ATDDEA or the EFA must pay the AON \$20.00 per event insurance levy.

Amendments to programme –

- The committee of the Atherton Tablelands & District Dressage & Equestrian Association Inc. reserves the right to alter, amend or cancel any event on the programme without notice.

Attire –

- Riders to wear gloves and appropriate safety headgear (ASA 3838) and **sleeved** shirts & tie, stock or ratcatcher. Jackets are optional. Other attire, saddlery and gear must comply with EFA regulations.

Prizes –

- Prizes and ribbons will be awarded at a presentation after the last test each day.
