CONDITIONS OF ENTRY:

- No phone entries or late entries will be accepted. There are no exceptions. Please use 1 entry form per rider. Please make sure your entry form is legible and clear. Direct debit entries must be accompanied by the receipt slip from your bank as confirmation that funds have transferred.
- If entering via email please delete the program section of the file and fill out the entry form – email only this section, present to organisers first thing on the day to sign the waiver. Do not send JPEG files please.
- EFA registration number and bridle number of horse and EFA membership number of rider must be included with nominations along with EFA details sticker for official classes.
- Official Pony Dressage will not be provided with a separate class.
- Riders may not compete in official and associate tests on the same horse. Riders may not compete in senior and junior classes on the same horse.
- Nominations not to exceed a maximum of three tests per day, per horse/rider combination. No more than 2 horses per rider per class.
- **PLEASE NOTE : There will be no callers allowed at this event.**
- Junior riders age as at 1st January 2009 Riders age 12 and over and riding a horse 14.2hh and over are eligible to register with EFA and ride Official.
- Young Riders are age 14 – 21. The year they turn 14 to the year they turn 21. It is not necessary for horse or rider to be EFA registered.
- Horses may compete at 2 consecutive levels only; Prelim./Novice, Novice/Elem., etc.
- Horses may compete HC below their EFA grading or one level above in Official, Associate or Junior classes.

- No refund on nomination fees will be given after the closing date unless a Vet's or Doctor's certificate is produced. 30% of the nomination fee will be withheld by the club for administration.
- Riders must sign the disclaimer form attached to the Entry Form. Riders compete at their own risk and must abide by the competition rules of the EFA and FNEG. Riders must be members of the FNEG and/or the EFA or pay the Day Insurance Levy of \$20.00 per day.
- The committee reserves the right to alter, amend or cancel any event on the programme without notice.
- Stabling on the REA grounds is available to horses competing in at least 2 classes on both days only – due to small numbers of stables available Stables can be booked and paid for by emailing info@redlynchequestrian.com by Thursday before the comp and direct debiting into the REA account. - Ribbons and prizemoney for Saturday classes will be presented on Saturday afternoon - Sunday classes and championships will be awarded at a presentation after the last test on Sunday. Only horses eligible for champion will be notified to be ready for a mounted presentation – these horses must be fully plaited and saddled for the presentation.
- You will be sent a copy of the draw via email. Please check the draw for your task and please present to the event coordinator 15 minutes before your job is due to commence.
